Overview

Ruaha is now Tanzania's second largest national park (after Nyerere NP) and offers excellent wildlife viewing. It is particularly good for spotting predators, including very large prides of lion and the endangered wild dog. Elephants and a variety of antelope species are another big draw to the park. It also has outstanding wilderness appeal, with limited exclusive, luxury camps available.

Nyerere National Park (formerly Selous GR) is Tanzania's largest national park. The lifeblood of this wilderness is the mighty Rufiji River and network of interconnected lakes. This abundance of water attracts lots of wildlife in the Dry season from June through October. Game drives are most rewarding for predator sightings, but boat and foot safaris add a different dimension to your stay.

Pemba is, with the exception of a strip of land along its eastern coast, a very fertile place: besides clove trees, the locals grow mainly rice, coconut, bananas, cassava, and red beans. Pemba is home to several dive sites, with steep drop-offs, untouched coral, and very abundant marine life.

Day 1

Arrival Zanzibar Int' Airport

Pick up from Zanzibar airport, you will be personally met by Tiem Tours representative and transferred to stone town at Jafferji House

Safari briefing at the hotel.

Day 2 & 3

Ruaha National Park

Depart from Zanzibar after breakfast, You will be transferred to the airport for your flight out departing at 0800am. You will fly towards the great rift valley flying into the Ruaha National park and arriving at Ruaha. You will be met upon arrival at Ruaha by your driver guide who will pick you up and drive you towards your camp. You will have an en-route game drive as you head to the camp. You will arrive at the camp in time for lunch and an afternoon sunset game drive. You will spend 2 nights at Ruaha there a couple of options on how you will spend your day, one is to depart for an early morning game drive with a picnic breakfast and return to camp for hot lunch, the second option departs for a full game drive with a picnic lunch returning camp for dinner. End of your day at a campfire

Accommodations: Ruaha River Lodge

Meal Plan: Half board

Day 4, 5 & 6

Ruaha - Nyerere National Park

In the morning you will fly from Ruaha to Nyerere National Park. It is a short flight and upon your arrival, you can do your first game drive. Meet your representative and transfer to the Impala Selous Camp, your home for the next two days. Ideally located in the spectacular Selous Game Reserve, this is the perfect base from which to explore Tanzania's least known, yet wildest, game reserve.

Spend the coming days going on game drives to see the great elephant herds and visiting the Rufiji River, the largest river in East Africa and home to the largest crocodile and hippo populations on the continent. After a day of river safaris and bush walks, return to the camp to relax.

Accommodations: Impala Selous camp

Meal Plan: Full board

Day 7-10

Pemba Island

After breakfast, you will then be transferred to the airstrip for a flight carries you from the Selous via Dar es Salaam and onwards from there to Chake Chake Airport on Pemba Island. A speedboat transfer whisks you from the airport to Fundu Lagoon, your barefoot paradise for the next 3 nights.

As famous for its private beach as its warm service and superb food and wine, Fundu's hillside suites are tucked into the tropical forest looking out over a classic Indian Ocean view. This is one of the world's top 5 diving destinations, but it remains a crowd-free hideaway thanks to the private beach and boat-only accessibility. Be as active or as restful as you like – there are plenty

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Pemba airport for your flight to Zanzibar, then board your onward flight back home.
